A qualified candidate is someone who is willing to work with the school chapter advisor, as well as with other students, to serve as a positive role model in the area of Chinese studies. Complete online club registration.

**Procedure for joining:** Eligible students will receive an invitation. Upon induction their senior year, students must pay their induction fee. Members must also complete the online club registration.

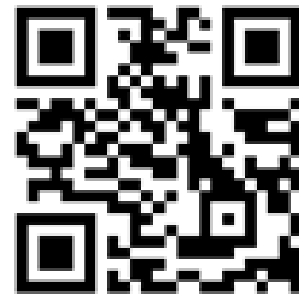
