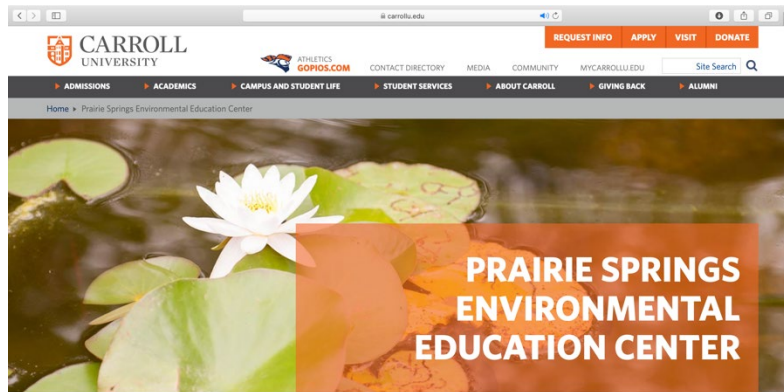


Prairie Springs On-Line Offerings
