Spring Holiday & April Calendar Changes

Please be aware of the following reminders and modifications to our District calendar as we continue our Virtual Learning into the month of April:

- Friday, April 10: remains a Non-Student Day

- **Tuesday, April 14: NEW Non-Student Day – used for teacher planning**
- Monday, April 27: remains a Non-Student Day – used for teacher professional learning

Other than the dates listed above, our virtual learning schedule for April will continue with Mondays as non-student days where staff can plan virtual lessons, and Tuesdays-Fridays as virtual learning days.

Food Service Schedule Changes for This Weekend

All OASD families in need, who have at least one student enrolled in an OASD school, will now be able to pick up a full week of breakfast and lunch “Grab and Go” meals for their students at Oconomowoc High School East Campus. Families do not need to be using the free and reduced lunch program to pick up these meals.

The next pick up dates and times are as follow:

- **Sunday, April 12: There will not be food pick up times on Easter Sunday**
- Monday, April 13: 8:00-10:00 a.m. or 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.

This program will continue as long as the OASD is closed and it will allow families an easy food pick-up plan. District social workers will be on hand to help families through this process. If you do not have a vehicle, please contact your school social worker for delivery arrangements.
