Food Service Schedule Next Week

All OASD families in need, who have at least one student enrolled in an OASD school, will now be able to pick up a full week of breakfast and lunch “Grab and Go” meals for their students at Oconomowoc High School East Campus. Families do not need to be using the free and reduced lunch program to pick up these meals.

The next pick up dates and times are as follow:

- **Monday, May 18: 8:00 – 10:00 a.m. or 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.**
- **Thursday, May 21: 4:00 – 6:00 p.m.**
- **Friday, May 22: 8:00 – 10:00 a.m.**
- **Memorial Day Weekend: No Meal Pick Up May 24 and 25**
