OASD Fall 2020 Return to School Plan

Today, the District is sharing the first edition of a comprehensive Fall 2020 Return to School Plan. This document will be updated continually as the OASD navigates the return to school and receives new information and guidance from local, County, and State agencies. Many factors are out of the District's control and will remain that way for the 2020-21 school year. The OASD will continue to work with State, County, and local agencies to adapt our plans to the changing COVID-19 pandemic.

The District has provided a significant amount of information to OASD families over the last four months, by email, on the OASD website, in OHS blog updates, within virtual learning platforms, and on the District social media pages. This information may have been overwhelming at times, but the OASD will continue to provide an abundance of information so that families and staff are informed of the District's work and the decision-making that affects our students, families, staff and community.

Online Registration for the 2020-21 School Year

Next week, the OASD will email the formal Online Registration information to families. Online registration will be open from July 20-August 6, 2020, and **all OASD families are required to complete this process** for each child. The District will ask families for their final learning scenario selections, per child, during this registration process.
