REMINDER: School Schedule Change Next Week

No School on March 15 & March 19

Through a new partnership with Walgreens, the OASD is able to offer an on-site COVID-19 vaccination clinic for OASD staff, Oconomowoc Transport staff, and Aramark staff on Friday, March 19. In order to provide the space and time to vaccinate such a large group, we will not have school on Friday, March 19. Students will not have in-person or virtual learning on March 19. Staff will have a professional work day with the opportunity to attend the vaccination clinic.

- Non-OASD/Private/Parochial families - please complete the "Online Family Access Registration Form" at www.oasd.org/SummerSchool. This form must be completed before registration every year, even if your child has attended OASD Summer School before.

There is a new class structure for Summer School this year so that students stay in a cohort group each session for face-to-face learning, and Summer School will again be offered for students entering 5K through 12th – grade.

REMINDERS

School Meals for Virtual Students

Breakfast and lunch are available for all OASD students on their virtual learning days during the 2020-21 school year. Students can order meals each week and pick up those meals every Monday at Oconomowoc High School. Student breakfast and lunch will continue to be free because of the USDA sponsored free meal program.

Families are required to complete a few simple steps on a weekly basis to receive these meals:

1. [Click this link to reach the online order form.](#)
2. Complete a separate order form for each student.
3. **Submit your student's order before 2:00 p.m. on Fridays so their meals are available the following week.**
4. Pick up meals on Mondays, between 4:00-6:00 p.m. for the entire week.
5. If a holiday or non-school day is on a Monday, meal pick up will occur on Tuesday, between 4:00-6:00 p.m.
6. If a school week is shortened because of a holiday or non-school day, the number of meals will be adjusted accordingly.
