NEW UPDATES

First Day of School in the OASD

We're excited to start the 2020-21 school year! The first day of school fluctuates slightly, depending on what grade your child is entering and whether they have a purple day or gold day schedule.

Elementary:

- Students entering 4K who are learning face-to-face will start school on Wednesday, September 2.
- Students entering grades 5K -4 who are learning face-to-face will start school on Tuesday, September 1.

Intermediate:

- Students entering grades 5-8 will start school on Tuesday, September 1.
- Students in the **PURPLE** cohort will attend Nature Hill and Silver Lake face-to-face on Tuesday, September 1. *Purple cohort students will have virtual learning and complete a "getting to know you" survey on Wednesday, September 2.*
- Students in the **GOLD** cohort will attend school virtually on September 1. Gold cohort students will receive information by email from their teacher on September 1, including a "getting to know you" survey. Gold cohort students will attend school in-person on Wednesday, September 2.

OHS:

- Students in grades 9-12 who are in the **PURPLE** cohort will start school at OHS on Tuesday, September 1. *Gold cohort students will not have online assignments.*
- Students in grades 9-12 who are in the **GOLD** cohort will start school at OHS on Wednesday, September 2. *Gold cohort students will not have online assignments.*

OVLC (All Grade Levels):

Students at all grade-levels in the Ocon Virtual Learning Community will start school on Tuesday, September 1.

Student Absence Reporting Process Reminder

This school year, it's more important than ever to keep children home if they're sick and accurately notify your child's school of the absence. There are two ways that families can report a student's absence to school, either by calling the school attendance line or using the Skyward Family Access system.

School Breakfast & Lunch for OVLC Students & Purple/Gold Virtual Students

All students in the OVLC and Purple/Gold students can order breakfast and lunch for their virtual school days. Meals are packed based on the number of virtual school days your child will have each week and families can pick up those meals every Monday at Oconomowoc High School.

A map of the pick up location and pricing for all the meal options is included in the form linked below. Families will be charged for meals through their child's Skyward Family Access account based on their student meal status, whether free, reduced or standard price.

Families are required to complete a few simple steps on a weekly basis:

- 1. Click this link to reach the online order form.
- 2. Submit your student's order before 2:00 p.m. on Fridays so their meals are available the following week.
- 3. Pick up meals on Mondays, between 4:00-6:00 p.m. for the entire week
 - OVLC students will receive meals for the entire school week.

- Students in grades 5-12 will receive meals for 2 or 3 days, depending on how many days they have virtual learning at home that week.
- 4. If a holiday or non-school day is on a Monday, meal pick up will occur on Tuesday, between 4:00-6:00 p.m.
- 5. If a school week is shortened because of a holiday or non-school day, the number of meals will be adjusted accordingly.
