



# OASD COVID-19 Mitigation Escalation Guidelines

We continue to monitor COVID-19 cases among staff and students. These are the guidelines we will use when increasing mitigation measures within a specific classroom, school, or district wide. Each situation is unique and the facts of each case will be used to make decisions on escalating the mitigation measures beyond what is listed here, if needed. These guidelines are subject to change and may change if vaccine availability and eligibility changes.

CONDITIONS



Case to case transmission in a classroom



Multiple case-to-case transmission in a grade level or across grade levels



7-day average positive cases\*\* in the OASD geographical region with a pattern of 12.5 or higher **and** correlating cases in a school



7-day average positivity\*\* in the OASD geographical region with a pattern of 20.0 or higher **and/or** significant or correlating case to case transmission in a school

## ELEMENTARY ESCALATION



Temporary mask requirement for classroom(s)\*



- Temporary mask requirement for grade level(s)\* **and/or**
- Possible temporary virtual learning for selected classes



Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 12.5



- Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 12.5 **or/then**
- Temporary 14-day virtual learning for entire school

## INTERMEDIATE GRADES 5 & 6 ESCALATION



Temporary mask requirement for classroom(s)\*



- Temporary mask requirement for grade level(s)\* **and/or**
- Possible temporary virtual learning for selected classes



Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 12.5



- Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 12.5 **or/then**
- Temporary 14-day virtual learning for selected class or grade-level

## INTERMEDIATE GRADES 7 & 8 ESCALATION



Reminder sent to families about mask recommendation due to increasing cases



Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 12.5



- Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 12.5 **or/then**
- Temporary 14-day virtual learning for selected class or grade-level

## OHS ESCALATION



Reminder sent to families about mask recommendation due to increasing cases



- Temporary school-wide mask requirement until patterned downturn below 20 **or/then**
- Possible short-term school closure (up to 5-days)
