ACCOMPLISHMENTS DURING THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR:

We were selected as a school of distinction by the Wisconsin RtI Center for our work accomplished through the implementation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS).

We were awarded the Kohl's Corporation school grant, which was utilized to defray the cost of classroom field trips.

We increased technology in classrooms for student use (Chrome Books, Kindles, Mini lap-tops).

We were selected as the elementary lab site for the Columbia Teacher's College professional development for third and fourth grades across the district.

Ixonía's third grade students were selected to perform "Goldilocks and the Three Bears" with the Florentine Opera at the Oconomowoc Arts Center.

We met our school learning objective of increasing the percent of students in sub groups who met their projected RIT scores.

SCHOOL PERFORMANCE: MAP TEST

Oconomowoc students in grades 5K to 8 take a computerized assessment called Measures of Academic Progress™ or MAP. These tests measure academic achievement in reading and mathematics. MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to a child's level of learning. As a result, a teacher may use the results to identify and tailor instruction to an individual student's unique achievement profile.

MAP tests also indicate the end-of-year achievement status of student groups (for example, all Ixonia 4th grade students) relative to a nationally representative group of MAP test takers. Percentile Rank scores are used to indicate where Ixonia students rank nationally in comparison to their grade level peers. Scores range from 1-99. A score of 50 represents the national average.
