Description of your session:

- 1. Book Recommendations Grades 4K-2** During this session parents will be given great book recommendations for your child to get excited about reading. There will be handouts given on titles that will engage readers of all kinds and the discussion will center on the many books the library has to offer for your child's grade and reading level.
- 2. Book Recommendations Grades 3-4:** During this session parents will be given great book recommendations for your child to get excited about reading. There will be handouts given on titles that will engage readers of all kinds and the discussion will center on the many books the library has to offer for your child's grade and reading level.
- 3. Early Literacy Grades 4K-1:** During this session parents will learn about early literacy activities that you can do at home to help your child be ready to read. We will go over a few pre-reading skills your child needs and move into early reading skills. You will also learn about early reading levels and the skills needed to move to the next level.
- 4. Literacy Grades 2-4** In this session, we will give a general overview of what literacy looks like in Second, Third and Fourth grade at Meadow View. We will share the progression of growth that students make in reading and some of the strategies that we focus on to grow lifelong readers. In addition, we will provide resources that will be helpful in encouraging and extending the learning for your young readers at home.
- 5. Stem Grades K-4:**
Teaching STEM in elementary grades opens the door for students to become tomorrow's movers and shakers! Students with a strong foundation in science, technology, engineering and mathematics will go on to play an integral role in our nation's global competitiveness and economic stability! We invite you to the new Learning Lab to discover what MDV's STEM program is all about!!
- 6. Chromebooks Grades 3+4:** During this session, families will learn about the amazing new technology introduced to students in third and fourth grade. Through the use of Chromebooks, students have access to a variety of online tools and resources. Families will get an inside peek about the chromebooks themselves and the ways they will be used for academics in the classroom.
- 7. Science Grades K-4:** During this session, families will learn about our new science curriculum and how it is anchored around phenomenon which supports students' natural curiosity to ask questions and conduct investigations to learn about the world around them.
- 8. Math Grades k-4:** During this session, parents will learn more about our math curriculum with a quick overview of classroom activities like Number Corner, Problem Investigations, and Work Places. Ideas for ways you can help at home including the Unit Family Letters, Home Connections and information about the Bridges in Math website will also be shared.
- 9. New Families to Meadow View Any Grade:** During this session Mr. Schreiber, our principal, would like to get to know you and your family. He will talk about Meadow View and answer any of your questions.
