We have approximately 230 students enrolled in four-year-old kindergarten through fourth grade. 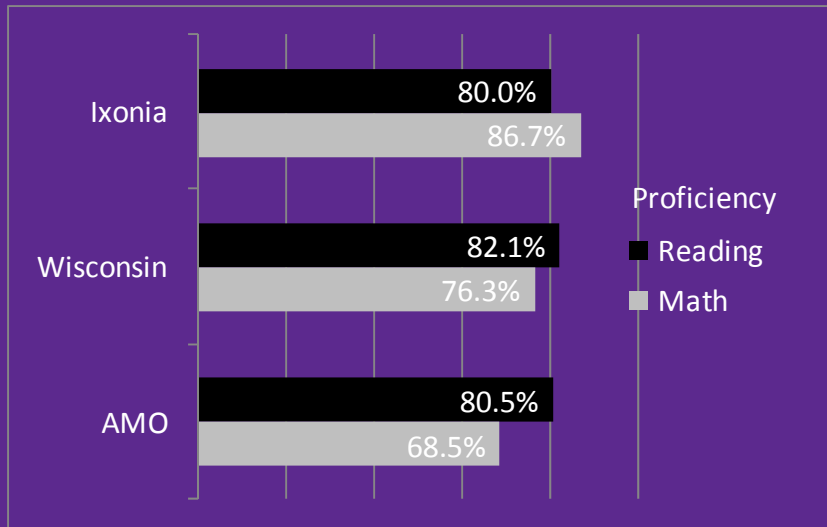

## Wisconsin Knowledge & Concepts Exams 2010

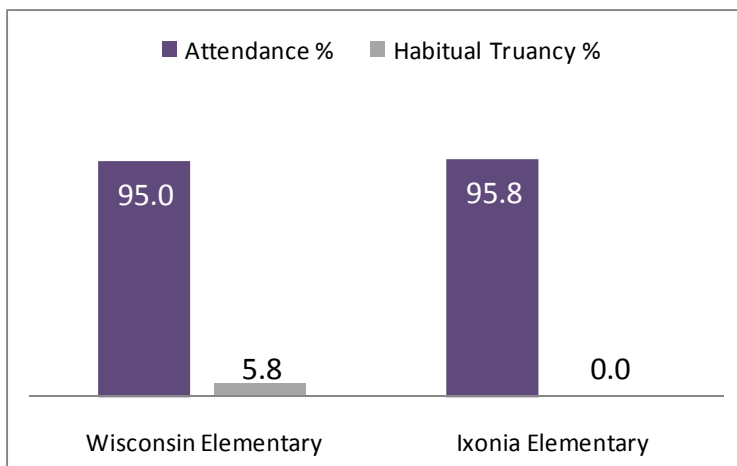


Ixonia students met Wisconsin annual measurable objectives (AMO) in reading and math.
